

LIST OF GENERATIONAL INIQUITIES

Consider iniquities as major crimes that would result in death according to the Laws of Moses in Leviticus. Highlight those iniquities that the Holy Spirit brings to your attention. Remember you do not have to have any knowledge of these events.

Shedding of Innocent Blood: Murder by instruments of torture, hanging, disembowelment, use of the axe, knife, sword, spear, arrow, rifle, gun; abortion, kidnapping, ambush of the innocent, slaughter; cruelty, and torture in times of war of captives and the innocent people in the land. Participation in acts of torture during the Inquisition, heartless destruction of life based on greed for power and wealth resulting in human trafficking, slave trading, slave ownership, and cruel oppression of people.

Treachery: false accusation against anyone, broken covenants, betrayals, and unfaithfulness in relationships with families, neighbors, communities, church, business, and nations. Destructive actions of treachery: against a spouse through adultery and children through incest, child molestation, neglect, and abandonment. Treachery against parents by robbery, cursing, dishonoring, and failing to provide for widows. Treachery against brothers and neighbors by lying, cheating, being a false witness, lying under oath, sowing discord among the brethren, being a talebearer, slanderer, gossip, using guile to gain advantage, exposing another's secrets, speaking with a perverse tongue that stirs up trouble and evil against another, holding hatred in one's heart, using a false balance or scale in business, moving the boundary stones and ancient landmarks, gaining inheritance by unjust means, giving and receiving bribes, securing wealth by a lying tongue, taking the fields of the orphans and widows, charging excessive interest for loans; using a corrupt judicial system to destroy another's life.

Use and Abuse of Others: through verbal, physical, emotional, spiritual, and sexual abuse, walking in hatred, strife, contention, ill temper, anger, and rage resulting in violence and cruelty; hating both God and man, blasphemy against God, willfully separating self from God and men, being a scorner, mocker, scoffer, hater of all that is pure and good, reckless speaking, flattering for gain, resentful envy and jealousy of another's life and blessings, seeking revenge, cursing others by thoughts, words, or actions, delighting in the destruction of another, purposeful lying to destroy another's life, human trafficking, slavery.

Idolatry: worshipping idols and expecting them to save you, stubbornly clinging to opinions and viewpoint, walking in self-sufficient independence; resisting man's and God's authority; withholding tithes and offerings; being lawless; coveting another's goods, life or spouse; idolizing works of one's hands, self, money, power, position, church/ denomination, intellect, career, accomplishments; hiding envy behind the cloak of insecurity and failure; needing the worship of others.

Gluttony: being greedy for food, chocolate or attention, being addicted to drugs, alcohol or sex, participating in drunkenness, orgies, gambling, and worldliness.

Self-Righteousness: shameful compromise in the face of danger, difficulty, or opposition; being a coward who justifies actions and wickedness, evades responsibility for actions; over-estimates oneself, spiritually; being willfully contrary in one's heart; being cold-hearted, hating instruction, discipline, and correction, living in a deliberate state of hypocrisy; being lukewarm, cold-hearted towards the needs of others and the poor; deluding oneself as being rich in spirit; being spiritually proud of dead works; covering up transgressions; being polluted by the leaven of the Pharisees or Sadducees; being unteachable, arrogant, proud, haughty, competitive, needing to be the best, being judgmental, critical, suspicious, legalistic; belonging to factions such as KKK, Freemasons; having a party spirit; disputing, being opinionated, fearing man rather than God, being a respecter of persons, showing partiality to the rich and powerful, making rash vows to God and others; believing religious lies like infant baptism has made you righteous before God.

Sexual Perversion: resulting in bastard¹ children born outside the protection of marriage, being polluted by the leaven of the Herodian; participating in fornication, molestation, incest, orgies, masturbation, bestiality, homosexuality, lesbianism, gender confusion, pornography; using woman, children, and men as objects of lust, impurity, and lewdness in thoughts, words, and actions; using filthy language, participating in masochism, sadism, and wicked imaginations.

Rebellion: participating in witchcraft through the control and manipulation of another's will; being stubborn (another form of idolatry); emasculation of men through female domination, hating men, hating females, hating one's sexual role and function, rebelling against the natural law through homosexuality; abdicating responsibility of leadership, abandoning of the family by the father or mother; being above the law of God and the government, resisting and opposing authority, and encouraging others to oppose lawful authority.



¹ **Bastard** - a child born of unmarried parents; an illegitimate child that was denied the right of inheritance. Sometimes referred to as the 'Curse of Illegitimacy'.
