

PROCLAMATION OF COVENANT

In Isaiah 43:26 (AMP), we are instructed: *Put Me in remembrance [remind Me of your merits]; let us plead our case, that you may be justified (proved right)*. In Luke 22:19, 20b (AMP), we remember the Lord's words: *Then He took a loaf [of bread], and when He had given thanks, He broke [it] and gave it to them saying, This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.* ²⁰*And in like manner, He took the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament or covenant [ratified] in My blood, which is shed (poured out) for you.*

By your covenant relationship with the Lord, you can come boldly to the Throne of God to receive mercy and grace in your time of need. It is important that you remind yourselves, the hosts of hell, the angel armies, and even Father God of Your covenant relationship. You are justified by the blood of Jesus and are in covenant relationship with a covenant keeping God.

When you have finished confessing your personal and generational sins and iniquities, it is important to seal your time of repentance through the Proclamation of Covenant with Communion.

I have been crucified with Christ. The life that I now live; I live by faith in the Son of God. I thank You for giving me the finest wheat. I bless this bread and declare that I am receiving Your life, Your strength, Your divine virtue into my body, soul, and spirit. I am receiving the DNA of Jesus Christ encoded with the memory of glory from the Mount of Transfiguration. I have complete salvation and shalom through the life in Your flesh. You were bruised for my iniquity. This day I bring the bruising in my generation to the Body of Jesus Christ. I receive healing and wholeness in every bruised area of my DNA. I declare that the Blood cleanses me

of all defilement and makes me holy, a sign of my covenant with You. I am a son of the Most High God, righteous in Your sight. I live in the Shalom of God
